

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**How to Enter**

**Duration Of Competition**

The Grocery Giveaway game of chance competition commences at 9am on Monday, 3 June 2019 and concludes at 9pm on Sunday, 30 June 2019.

**Conditions of Entry**

- 2) Customers may enter more than once, but each entry requires one qualifying purchase transaction within the promotional period for valid entry.
- 3) One entry valid per eligible spend.
- 4) Entrants may be asked to provide receipt/s of transaction to win a prize.
- 5) To be valid, all entry fields completed via the entry form.
- 6) Entry is only open to Australian residents.
- 7) Website entry pages close at 9pm on Sunday, 30 June 2019. Any entry received after this time will not qualify.
- 8) Employees and contractors of the Promoter, retailers and tenants of Charter Hall managed Shopping Centres or the agencies associated with this promotion and members of each of their immediate families are ineligible to enter. For the purposes

of this clause, immediate families mean parents, siblings, spouse (as defined in *the Family Law Act 1975 (Cth)*), children, grandparents or persons otherwise residing in the same household.

#### **Date, Time and Place of Draw**

The daily winners of the Grocery Gift Card will be drawn at 11am every Monday for the duration of the promotional period: 10 June, 17 June, 24 June and 1 July, 2019.

- 1) On each competition draw date, seven daily winners from the week prior will be drawn. Each valid entry drawn in sequence, will be awarded the daily prize.
- 2) The decision is final. No further correspondence will be entered into.
- 3) Each winner will be notified via phone call to confirm the best postal address for the prize to be sent.
- 4) Entrants do not need to be present at the time of draw.
- 5) If despite reasonable effort the winner's prize is returned to sender, the prize will be retained for three (3) months. At the end of the three (3) months being 1 October 2019, if the prize remains unclaimed, a letter will be sent to the Office of Liquor, Gaming and Racing setting out full details and steps taken to try and contact the winner/s. At that stage a request for redraw will be sought.

## **Customers Information and privacy**

- 1) By entering the promotion, entrants give the Promoter consent to use personal information, in accordance with the Charter Hall Privacy Policy (available on the Charter Hall website), for further purposes and promotions unless you say otherwise.
